

Your Voting Guide for November 2020

How do I know I'm registered to vote?

How Do I Register to Vote?

If you are NOT registered to vote but have a NC drivers license, you can now register to vote ONLINE. Click on this site to register online. <https://www.ncdot.gov/dmv/offices-services/online/Pages/voter-registration-application.aspx>

Early Voting

Early Voting for the November 3rd General Election runs from **Thursday, October 15th until Saturday Oct 31st.**

If you are **NOT** registered to vote, you **CAN** register and vote during this time period. During Early Voting, you can vote at any early voting site in Madison County.

If you prefer to vote **ON** election day, **Tuesday November 3rd**, you must register to vote by **FRIDAY OCTOBER 9TH.**

If voting on election day, you **MUST** vote at your precinct.

Absentee Ballot Information

ANY registered North Carolina voter can Vote by Mail — no excuses or special circumstances required!

Voting by Mail is easy! Here's what you have to do:

Start by submitting a **Mail-In Ballot Request form!**

How to submit your request:

Absentee Ballot Info (continued)

In Person: drop it off at the Madison County BOE:

Marshall, NC 28753

When you receive your ballot:

Fill it out in the presence of **1 witness.** Your witness can be anyone, as long as they are 18 or older!

Put your ballot back in the envelope they provide and fill out the information on the envelope and then you and your 1 witness **MUST** sign the envelope.

Absentee Ballot Info (continued)

Ballots can be returned:

By Mail to the Madison County BOE.

By dropping the ballot off at one of the three early voting sites.

dropping off the ballot in person at the Madison County BOE

Your completed Ballot must be received by your County Board of Elections **no later than 5:00 P.M. on Election Day: Tuesday, November 3rd.**
